Madame Guyon, a student of the Bible in the 1600's wisely writes: "If you read quickly, it will benefit you little. You will be like a bee that merely skims the surface of a flower. Instead, in this new way of reading with prayer, you must become as the bee who penetrates into the depths of the flower. You plunge deeply within to remove the deepest of nectar."

This year, let's read small portions of the Bible meditatively and prayerfully, inviting God to meet us so that his Word may transform us to become more like Jesus. Come to each portion you read with the desire to have a holy meeting with God.

Getting Started: The goal of this kind of reading and reflecting is not for us to get through the Scriptures, but to let the Scriptures get through us. Here's a suggested way to begin:

1. Be still and invite God to speak to you during this time with a simple prayer:

"Dear Lord, as I begin this time in your holy Bible, I open my heart to listen to you. I know that even a child can hear your voice. I pray with the little boy Samuel, "Speak Lord, for your servant is listening" (1 Samuel 3:9, 10).

2. Read the passage and notice what word or phrase stands out to you. It may help to write it down. In silence meditate on that.

3. What thoughts or emotions rise to the surface? What specific situation in your life today relates?

4. What is God's personal invitation to you from the Scripture passage? Is there any action, response or step of obedience God wants you to make? You can write down what the Lord may be saying to you or offer a prayer of thanks. Or simply rest quietly in the Spirit's presence.
